IHBG - HOME-BASED EDUCATION

Children who participate in a nonpublic home-based educational program shall not be subject to compulsory school attendance as provided by Colorado law and District Policy JH/JHB. Parents/guardians establishing nonpublic home-based educational programs for their children are subject to the following requirements in accordance with governing law:

1. The parent/guardian shall submit written notification of the establishment of the program to the assistant director of student outreach 14 days prior to the establishment of the program and each year thereafter if the program is maintained. The parent/guardian shall certify in writing on a form provided by the District the name, age, place of residence and number of hours of attendance of each child enrolled in the program.
